Every Kid Can Play Grant Program Non-Profit Organizations of a Provincial Scope and Community-Level Organizations

Purpose

The Every Kid Can Play Grant Program (EKCP) addresses affordability and accessibility challenges for Alberta kids and their families to sport, physical activity, and recreation (SPAR) programs. Funding is available for non-profit organizations that are not affiliated or registered members of a provincial scope organization (i.e. provincial sport or recreation organization) to reduce costs associated with the delivery, expansion, or enhancement of existing community-level programs.

What is the application period?	Applications will open on July 18, 2023, with a closing date for submissions of September 30, 2023, at 11:59PM.
Where should I submit my program or application questions?	General inquires can be referred to <u>SPAR@gov.ab.ca</u> . Online information sessions will be scheduled in July, August and September.
Who is eligible for funding?	A registered non-profit organization that has been operating in Alberta for a minimum of one calendar year, and is in good standing under one of the Acts identified in the EKCP.
	For programing offered by community-level organizations, an unregistered/informal group partnered with an eligible registered non-profit organization.

Who is ineligible for funding?	 The following organizations are ineligible for funding: Organizations not registered under one of the Alberta Acts deemed eligible; Organizations affiliated or registered members of a provincial scope organization (i.e. provincial sport or recreation organization) are ineligible to apply under Community-Level funding; For-profit organizations; Government departments, public agencies, or other public institutions; Municipalities; Post-secondary institutions; Schools or School Boards; Organizations with outstanding reporting to the Ministry of Culture; and Individuals.
