

# SPORT TECHNICAL PACKAGE ALPINE SKIING

## **AGE GROUP**

U14 (12-13 years of age as of December 31, 2025)

Year of Birth: 2012-2013

### **ZONE TEAM COMPOSITION**

The maximum team size shall be:

- <u>10</u> athletes per Zone (# of females <u>5</u> # of males <u>5</u>) 2 coaches per Zone (# of females 1 # of males 1)
- $\frac{1}{2}$  chaperones per Zone (# of females  $\frac{1}{1}$  # of males  $\frac{1}{1}$ )

## **FILL POLICY**

- 1. The results from the time trials will determine a Zone team list and a Zone alternates list ranked in the finish order of the time trials.
- 2. Should there be a need to fill; the first opportunity will be provided from the Zone alternates list.
- 3. If there is a need to fill in from outside the Zone, the fills shall come from the respective northern and southern time trials and award the fastest athlete not already selected in the time trial to fill the quota.
- 4. Zones 1-4 (Southern time trial) and 5-8 (Northern Time Trial) will be grouped together for the purpose of determining fills.

Fills must be submitted for approval to the Multisport Games Unit by January 13, 2026.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

## **Athletes**

- Athletes must be registered with Alpine Canada Alpine as a national card U14 Competitor and be a member in good standing with Alberta Alpine
- Members of an Alberta Alpine club must compete for the Zone where the club has been assigned to by Alberta Alpine.
- Must be a member of an Alberta Alpine Club or have their principal residence in Alberta
  - Members who meet the eligibility requirements that are not a member of an Alberta alpine club must compete for the Zone of his/her principal residence.

## Coaches/Chaperones

- <u>NCCP Certification</u> Head Coaches must be minimally Certified at the National Coaching
   Certification Program (NCCP) Development Level. Assistant Coaches must be minimally Trained at
   the NCCP Development Level. All Coaches must be a current paid up member as an Alpine Skiing
   Coach and licensed for the 2025/2026 season.
- Safe Sport SafeSport Requirements for all coaches and chaperones by the registration deadline:
  - Must have a clear criminal records and vulnerable sector check from within the last three (3) years, or less if required by your organization's policies with ACA or AASA.
  - Must have completed the CAC Safe Sport Training.



# SPORT TECHNICAL PACKAGE ALPINE SKIING

Note: Where a coach or chaperone has been substituted after the registration deadline leading into the Games, they must have the above completed and verified with Mission Staff no later than 48 hours prior to the start of the Alberta Games.

All coaches and chaperones must be at least eighteen (18) years old by the start of the Alberta Games.

#### **AFFILIATION**

All athletes and coaches must be registered with an Alpine Canada Alpin member club and hold a 2025-2026 U14 national competitor card. The athlete must be registered with their club prior to the Zone playoff entry deadline.

## **ENTRY AND ZONE PLAYOFF PROCEDURES**

- AASA will organize the northern and southern time trial in accordance with the Alberta Alpine Ski
  Association's technical format. In order to qualify for the Alberta Winter Games team, an athlete
  must attend the time trials. Athletes will be selected for Alberta Winter Games on the basis of time
  trial results.
- In addition, an "alternates" list will be established.
- Each Zone team must be selected by January 12, 2026.

### ALBERTA GAMES REGISTRATION FEE AND DEADLINE

All Zone team athletes, who qualify to compete at the 2024 Alberta Winter Games (excluding coaches and chaperones), are required to pay an individual registration fee of \$80.00. This fee will offset the costs related to transportation, accommodation, meals, Zone identification, medals, athlete entertainment and sport competitions. Information on the collection of this fee(s) will be available in the final technical package.

Please note the registration deadline for Alpine Skiing is January 12, 2026.
