AGE GROUP(S)

- Cub Recurve 12-14 years of age (as of Dec. 31, 2020)
- Cadet Recurve 15-17 years of age (as of Dec. 31, 2020)
- Cub Compound 12-14 years of age (as of Dec. 31, 2020)
- Cadet Compound 15-17 years of age (as of Dec. 31, 2020)

ZONE TEAM COMPOSITION

The maximum team size shall be:

8 athletes per Zone (# of females 4 # of males 4)

1 coach and 1 manager per Zone (1 female & 1 male between the 2 positions)

FILL POLICY

Any Zone which does not have an archer assigned to a particular category after their Zone trials, will forfeit the opportunity to send a representative archer for that category. This spot will be filled by alternate archers from other Zones based on a highest to lowest trials score ranking system. If the position is filled by another Zone athlete, that athlete will represent the Zone in which he/she lives.

Only official Zone trials scores will be used to rank all archers across the Province in each category.

*Cub archers may be used in the cadet category as fill if required.

Fill athletes will not compete in the “team” event.

Fills must be submitted for approval to the Alberta Sport Connection by **January 1, 2020**.

ELIGIBILITY

Athletes

- Athletes must be members of Archery Alberta.
- Members who have competed on Canadian Teams attending any international championships or Canada Winter Games are ineligible.
- Athletes shall compete in the Zone in which he/she resides without exceptions. If an athlete resides in more than one Zone the athlete must declare their intention to compete for one of their Zones and may not compete for a team space in any other Zone.
- Athletes may only try out in one discipline at playoffs.

Coaches

- All coaches and chaperones must be at least eighteen (18) years old by the start of the Alberta Games.
- All coaches and chaperones must have had a recent criminal record and vulnerable sector check and provide those results to the Provincial Sport Coordinator when named for the role.
- All coaches and chaperones must stay in the athlete's village with athletes. Coaches may not sleep off site.
- **NCCP Certification** – A minimum of one (1) member per Zone of the staff must be registered as a fully certified Coach under the National Coaching Certification Program to at least Instructor Beginner. If a Zone does not have a certified coach they must contact the Archery PSO to discuss what options are available to the Zone.

AFFILIATION

Affiliation with the ATAA is \$41.00 if not a member and \$38.00 if the club is affiliated. Contact the nearest club or email the membership secretary at membership@archeryalberta.ca. Affiliation is mandatory by the day of Zone trials (playoffs).

PROVINCIAL GAMES REGISTRATION FEE AND DEADLINE

All Zone team athletes, who qualify to compete at the 2020 Alberta Winter Games (excluding coaches and chaperones), are required to pay an individual registration fee of \$80.00. This fee will offset the costs related to transportation, accommodation, meals, Zone identification, medals, athlete entertainment and sport competitions. This fee must accompany the athlete's registration form for the Provincial Games.

You MUST have your trials paperwork and athlete registration complete and to our Provincial Sport Coordinator, Brian Struthers, by December 23, 2019. Failure to do so could result in an athlete losing their spot on the Zone team.

EVENTS

The competition will be governed by Archery Canada rules with the exception of:

- All archers (despite age and category) will shoot 40 cm targets.
- Qualifying round will consist of two 300 rounds.
- Individual medal rounds will consist of 4 ends of 3 arrows in a double elimination match play.
- Team medal rounds consisting of 4 ends of 4 arrows (2 per archer) in single elimination match play.

Archery Canada (AC) Compound and Recurve equipment rules will apply

ENTRY AND ZONE PLAYOFF PROCEDURES

- Zone playoffs for the Alberta Games will be held prior to **December 18, 2019**.
- Athletes may only try out in one discipline (Recurve or Compound) at playoffs.
- Athletes may only shoot their team trials on the specified trials date at the specified location for their Zone. Special consideration for this may be given for special circumstances (such as medical situations) but this must be requested of and approved by the Provincial Sport Coordinator. If special consideration is granted athletes can still only qualify for a team space by shooting in a different Zone trials (no other tournament will be accepted) and it must be done before their Zone shoots their trials.
- Entries will be sent to and received by the Provincial Sport Coordinator prior to **December 23, 2019**.
- All Zone playoffs will consist of a FITA 300 round. A provincial judge is required for these playoffs.
