

# BASKETBALL



## AGE GROUP(S)

Under 14 years of age as of January 1, 2018

Years of Birth: 2004 or later

## ZONE TEAM COMPOSITION

The maximum team size shall be:

24 athletes per zone (# of females 12 # of males 12)

4 coaches or chaperones per zone (# of females 12 # of males 12)

(At least one (1) coach/chaperone must be the same gender as the team)

## FILL POLICY

A fill team will be added from the same zone which needs to be filled.

If a fill team is still needed, the next team will be taken from the Zone with the largest tryout numbers.

Lastly, the third option will come from the next closest centre from where the original fill was needed.

## ELIGIBILITY

### *Athletes*

- Athletes must be a registered member of Basketball Alberta,
- Athletes must meet the age requirement and reside within their Zone of play.

### *Coaches*

- Basketball Alberta NCCP Certified to a minimum of **Level 1 or Learn to Train** (in training status and actively pursuing certification) must be completed by a minimum of one (1) member of the Zone staff registered as coaches.
- All coaches and chaperones must be at least eighteen (18) years old by the start of the Alberta Games.

## AFFILIATION

Athletes wishing to compete for the Alberta Summer Games must be member of Basketball Alberta.

## ALBERTA GAMES – ATHLETE REGISTRATION FEE AND DEADLINE

All Zone team athletes, who qualify to compete at the 2018 Alberta Summer Games, are required to pay an individual registration fee of **\$60.00**. This fee will go towards offsetting

the costs related to transportation, accommodation, meals, zone identification, medals, athlete entertainment and sport competitions. This fee must accompany the athlete's registration form for the Alberta Games.

Please note that the registration deadline for Basketball is **June 10, 2018**.

## **EVENTS**

- Male - Eight (8) Team Tournament
- Female - Eight (8) Team Tournament

Eight (8) teams in each event, separated by two (2) - four (4) team pools; cross-over semi-final and final. Eighteen (18) games will be played in both the female and male tournaments. Each team is guaranteed four (4) games.
