16U – Athletes born September 1, 2001
to December 31, 2002

ZONE TEAM COMPOSITION

The maximum team size shall be:

4 per zone	(# of females 2	# of males 2)
16 coaches or chaperones	(# of females 8	# of males 8)

FILL POLICY

- The first opportunity to fill is provided to the Host Zone.
- The second opportunity to fill is provided to the Zone next to the Host with the greatest participation at the selection camp.

Fills must be submitted for approval to the Alberta Sport Connection by **June 15, 2018**

ELIGIBILITY

Athletes

- 16U – Athletes born September 1, 2001 to December 31, 2002
- Athletes must tryout in the Zone in which they reside, and register for tryouts on the volleyballalberta.ca website

Coaches

- One Head Coach will be selected for each Zone and will coach the boy's and girls' team. It is recommended that the Head Coach has experience coaching beach volleyball. The coach must be registered member with Volleyball Alberta and have **completed the Volleyball eLearning, Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation, and the Making Head Way online modules.**
- If a Head Coach would like an Assistant Coach, they must be approved by Volleyball Alberta and complete the necessary paperwork and Alberta Games registration prior to June 15, 2018.
- All coaches and chaperones must be at least eighteen (18) years old by the start of the Alberta Games.

AFFILIATION

Athletes must be registered with the Volleyball Alberta Association. Contact Volleyball Alberta, or check out www.volleyballalberta.ca for more information on affiliation fees.

ALBERTA GAMES – ATHLETE REGISTRATION FEE AND DEADLINE

All Zone team athletes, who qualify to compete at the 2018 Alberta Summer Games, are re-

quired to pay an individual registration fee to Volleyball Alberta of **\$160.00**. This fee will offset costs related to transportation, accommodation, meals, zone identification, medals, athlete entertainment, sport competitions, equipment, uniforms, and coaching honorariums. This fee must be paid by July 2.

Please note that the registration deadline for Volleyball - Beach is **June 15, 2018**.
