

CURLING (MIXED DOUBLES)

AGE GROUP(S) & CATEGORIES

30 years of age and over (born before January 01, 1989)

Teams will be comprised of two (2) players
- one male and one female

20 team tournament

(Open registration for 19 teams across Alberta, 1 spot held for Rocky Curling club competitors. Non-local teams will have first opportunity to fill the event)



ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY & AFFILIATION

Open to all eligible curlers meeting age requirements, who reside within the Curling Alberta boundaries. For more information regarding Alberta Curling Federation affiliation, check out www.curlingalberta.ab.ca

In the event the competition does not reach capacity, the tournament will be back-filled locally.

EVENT(S)

Four (4) pools of five (5) Teams.

Round Robin – Four (4) games; play offs based on Round Robin performance, Playoff maximum Two (2) games.

Competition will be scheduled for Friday August 23 – Sunday August 25, 2019

Competition based on Canadian Curling Association, Rules of Curling General Play 2018-2019, #18 Mixed Doubles.

Teams are required to wear Team Apparel, matching jackets, vests and or sweaters. All brush heads must be WCF compliant; no other brush heads allowed. To start competition, draw closest to the button will be used to determine which team will get decision of placement of “positioned stones”. Each player will be allowed two practice stone per game prior to the start of the game.

Closest to the button stones will be measured in each pool game. Measured stones must be alternating male-female from game to game. Two measured stones from male thrower and two measured stones from female thrower. These cumulative measurements will be used to break pool ties if required.

Teams are expected to follow intent of Thinking Time Rules (Curling Alberta Competitor's Guide, Appendix: Mixed doubles) 24 minutes not 22 as the rule states of Thinking time. Teams not following the intent will be warned and may be timed in the following game. All Pool playoff games will be timed. Offending team exceeding their Thinking Time will not be allowed to deliver any further stones. Each player will be allowed one practice stone per game prior to start of game. Lockers provided.

PROTEST PROCEDURES

The Alberta Masters Games will be played under the Canadian Curling Association "Rules of Mixed Doubles Play".

On Ice Protests: All efforts should be made to settle disputes in accordance with Curling Code of Ethics and Fair play. Should this fail, the Head Official(s) will make the final decision.
