AGE GROUP(S) & CATEGORIES

AGE CATEGORIES: 30 - 39, 40 - 49, 50 - 59, 60+

Minimum age 30 years of age (Born before Dec 31, 1989;

Maximum age: Open

120 Athletes maximum per event – 60 female & 60 male

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY & AFFILIATION

Residents of Alberta who have NOT held an Union Cycliste International, Cycling Canada, or Alberta Bicycle Association Category 1 & 2 Road or MTB Elite level license in the previous two years prior to the competition date.

Eligible athletes must possess an Alberta Bicycle Association License in categories lower than Cat 2 and below Elite. For information regarding ABA affiliation and licensing, check out www.albertabicycle.ab.ca/membership-licensing

The Alberta Masters Games are open to residents of Alberta.

EVENTS

Event 1) Mountain Bike Cross Country Olympic (XCO);

Event 2) Cyclo-Cross (CX);

Event 3) Road Race (RR)

Combined all three for a Stage Race. (4 medals will be awarded)

Number of Laps and distance to be determined by the Commissaire's prior to the event as per UCI, CC & ABA guidelines for each of the events and announced prior to the event.

MTB XCO Event - Friday August 23 from 9:00am – Noon

CX Event – Saturday August 24 from 5:00pm – 7:00pm

RR Event – Sunday August 25 from 8:00am – 11:00am

Format & Rules are as per the Union Cycliste Internationale, Cycling Canada & Alberta Bicycle Association Rules & regulations including Companion guide and event Organizers guide.

PROTEST PROCEDURES

As per the guidelines and rules set out by the Union Cycliste Internationale, Cycling Canada, and Alberta Bicycle Association rules and regulations and Companion Guides in effect at the time of Competition.

FACILITY INFORMATION

1) Mountain Bike (XCO) 50 km south west of Rocky Mountain House in Clearwater County at Baseline Mountain on the XCO course.

2) Cyclo-Cross (CX) creation of a new CX course on the Rocky Mountain House walking, cycling path north from 59th Ave North of the Big Rock to the Toboggan Hill north of the trail to about 67th Ave.

3) Road Race (RR): Start/Finish Will Sinclair Drive heading south from the Christenson Sports Center to Hwy 11A west out to Pine Hills Golf course and back on Hwy 11.
